

School Meals

School meals are now £2.33 (£11.65 per week).

Please note that at least 1 week's notice must be given IN WRITING for any changes between school meals and packed lunches and vice versa. Sodexo

have to order food one week in advance so it is not possible to chop and change from one day to another as this causes confusion all round!

School meals are available for either:

- The whole week
- A Wednesday (roast) only
- A Wednesday (roast) and Friday (fish) only.

Cheques should be made out to Sodexo and placed in a named envelope in the black box marked 'Sodexo' located in the entrance porch. This is checked regularly.



Christmas Lunch will be available on Friday 5th December for all children — Sodexo will be sending out a letter.

Please Name Everything!

Parking outside School


We would politely ask parents not to park on
